



# Alpha Street Reconstruction Project Info

## Construction Information:

The City has contracted Moorefield Excavating, as the General Contractor, to oversee and complete the reconstruction project of Alpha Street from 6th Ave W (apartment buildings) to Grey Road 17 B (Nicol's Gully Road).

## Road Access & Detour:

Alpha Street will be closed throughout the project. There will be signs showing another way to go (detour shown below).

During construction, people who live on or near Alpha Street can still use the roads (local traffic), but expect delays. You can still walk in the area while the work is happening. Shops and businesses in the area will remain accessible during construction.



## Impacts:

### Garbage & Recycling

Garbage and recycling will still be picked up on the usual days. Make sure to put your waste out by 7:00 a.m. **Please label your bins with your home address during the Alpha Street construction!** The Contractor team will move bins for pickup, but they'll bring them back to where they belong, as long as they're labelled with your address.

### Home Property

The project is planned to stay entirely within the City's road allowance, but there might be a bit of work on private property for service connections. During construction, there might be some shaking and noise. The Contractor will ask to check the condition of each building before starting. If anything like the sidewalk, driveways, or yards are affected, they will be fixed to be just as good or even better condition than before.

### Utility Interruptions

At certain points throughout the project, those who live in and around the project area may experience water service interruptions. The contractor on site will notify affected residents before this happens. From 6th Ave W to Nicol's Gully Road, where water pipes are being replaced, water will still be supplied using a temporary system. The Contractor can give more details about when and how this temporary system will be set up.

### Transit & School Bus Services

Owen Sound Transit Brooke and Core routes will be affected beginning April 22, 2024. Please see the alternative routes map on the back of this page. The Mobility Bus will still be able to pick up registered riders as needed. Some area school bus routes and stops will be affected by construction.
