ABOUT US

Owen Sound Transit operates 4 bus routes in the City. All of the conventional buses are fully accessible. For customers who are unable to use conventional transit, Owen Sound Transit provides mobility transit services, including door-to-door service using specialized vehicles.

WHAT CAN I BRING?

BICYCLES

Bikes should be carried on the bike rack located on the front of the bus. Children's bikes that do not fit on the rack may be brought on board if space permits.

Skateboards, Roller Blades, Roller Skates etc: Items cannot be worn and must be carried before entering buses

STROLLERS

Strollers must be able to fit through the front doors and down the aisles in order to board the bus. Aisles must not be blocked.

PETS

Small animals that are kept inside a crate/enclosure are allowed on buses.

SERVICE ANIMALS

If you have a service animal, please remember:

- *The animal must be under your care and control at all times.*
- *Service animals must not pose a risk to other passengers or to bus operators.*
- *If it is not clear that the animal is a service animal, the bus operator may ask you for a note from a regulated health professional stating that the animal is needed for reasons of a disability.*

LARGE ITEMS

No large or unsecured carry-on items that could inconvenience other riders, be offensive or dangerous.

ACCESSIBILITY

Owen Sound Transit's conventional buses are equipped with features to make them fully accessible.

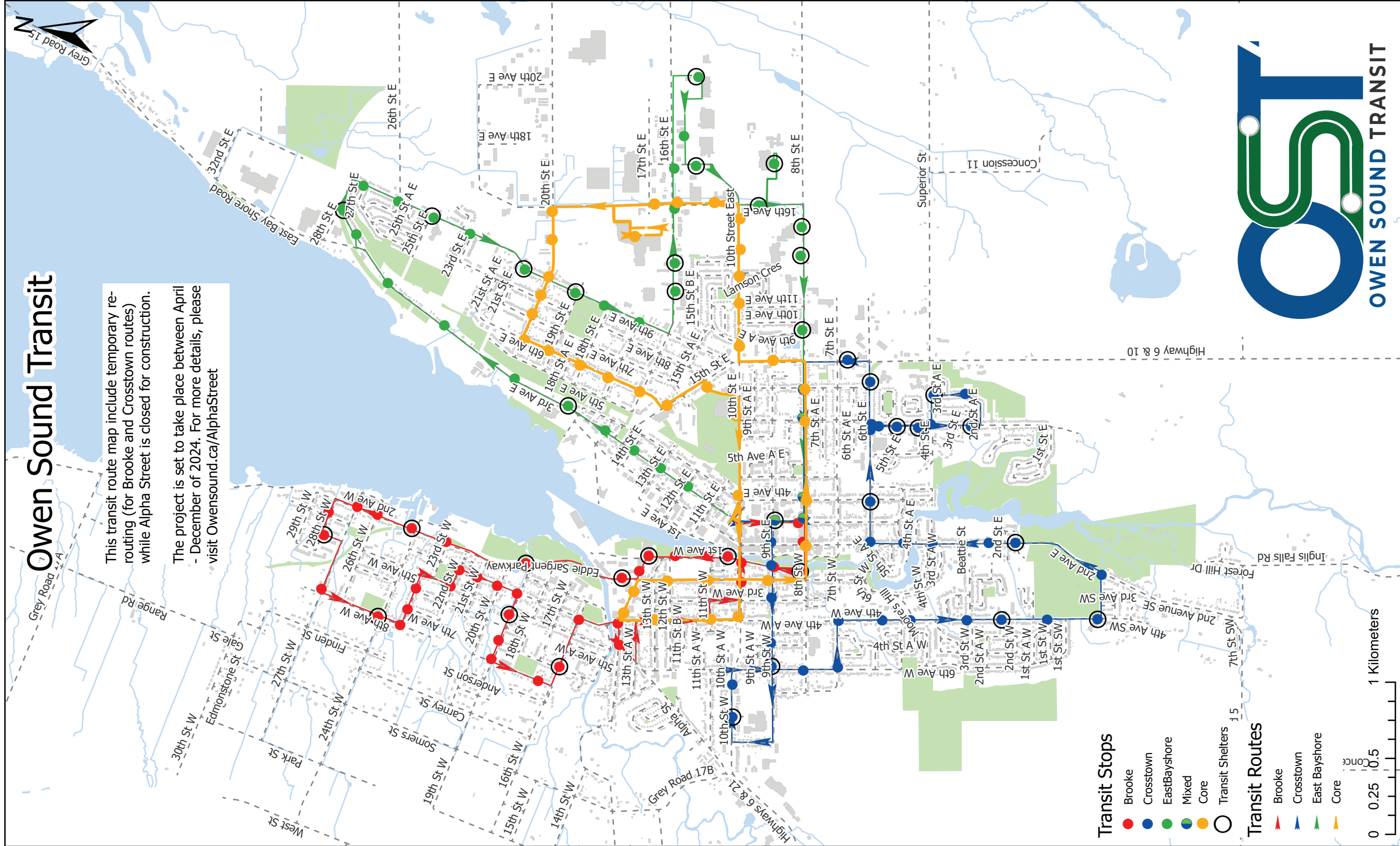
