

Commemorative Bench Program

The Process

The first step is for the family/group to decide on an appropriate location to have a bench installed. Parks staff will assist with the site selection for those wishing a site in a City park and Cemetery staff will assist with the arrangements for those wishing a bench installed in Greenwood Cemetery.

The financial contribution to participate in the program is \$4113.18 plus HST (subject to change with Council approval) for the purchase, delivery, and installation of the bench on a concrete pad.

After the bench is installed, the City assumes ownership and responsibility for ongoing maintenance of the bench.

Plaques

Commemorative plaques may be installed to identify the commemorative bench and are included in the program fee. The plaques are made of durable Corian® and can be inscribed with wording of your choice, provided the number of letters can suitably be accommodated.

The City of Owen Sound is not responsible for the maintenance or replacement of commemorative plaques.
